

Belukha is the heart of Asia (summer 2021)

Mountain Belukha, the highest peak in Siberia, flies up with two summits: Western Belukha (4440 meters) and Eastern Belukha (4506 meters). The glacier shield of Belukha, which covers the largest part of the mountain ridge, occupies the territory of 70 sq km and is the source of Katun river. The steep peaks of Belukha, sparkling masses of ice, vertical rocky walls charm the travelers from afar and inspire them with awe and excitement. At the mountain's feet among the space mysteries of snow and rocks you become aware that the man is not always the measure of all things. According to one Asian legend Mountain Belukha is a future Northern Shambala a mystical country of spiritual wisdom. This area is associated with the famous Russian artist Nikolay Rerikh and attracts hundreds of admirers of his painting every year. In 1995 the government of Altai Republic established the Belukha nature park.

For 10 days of trekking, each tourist will have the opportunity:

- to see with your own eyes a mountain with a height of 4509 meters, which majestically rises among the plains;
- walk along the Kucherla River and admire its milky-white waters;
- independently overcome the passes on foot, thereby increasing their physical fitness;
- climb the Kara-Turek pass and take beautiful panoramic pictures of the view of the mountain Belukha and the Kantun ridge;
- make a wish in a place of power a mystical valley called Yarlu;
- to see more than 100 cave paintings;
- spend the night in a tent among the ancient forest, which is full of mysteries and secrets;
- imbibe a piece of nature of the amazing Altai and energize.

0 day	Novosibirsk - Ust-Koksa Departure from Novosibirsk at 20:00. Point of departure - Sovetskaya street, 65 (local time, UTC/GMT+7). Barnaul - Ust-Koksa. Departure from Barnaul at 23:50. 1 day	Gorno-Altaisk - Ust-Koksa Departure from Gorno-Altaisk at 9.00-11.00 a.m. The road passes through the well-known Chuya Highway among rocky ridges of the Altai Mountains, followed by Kanskaya steppe in Uymonskaya valley. Arriving at Ust-Koksa village to the tourist complex. Lunch. Getting equipment. Safety-awareness briefing. Dinner, acquaintance party. 2 day	Early awakening. Moving to Tyungur at 8.00 AM. Ascending along the Kucherla river After transfer to Tyungur we change to GAZ-66 spetial off-road car to move at Elan place (around 12 km). The Kucherla River (from Altai "Kudzhurly", which means "with saline soils"), formed by the confluence of two mountain streams, Myushtu-Ayry and Koni-Ayry, has an amazing milky-turquoise water. The total length of the river is about 50 km. It cuts a lot of ridges and moraines, beats against the gorges, forming an almost continuous chain of challenging rapids. 3 day	Moving to Kucherla Lake The lake is 5220 m long, at 1790 m above sea level elevation, 900 m wide and 55 m deep. The Kucherla Valley has more than 40 tectonic, corrie and moraine lakes. The Kucherla Lake is the largest of them. It is closed by mountain ridges from east and west with loosened rocks up to 3,000 m high, narrow valley of the Kucherla from south and moraine deposits that create a dam from north. The lake is filled with ice, greenish-blue water.	Travel mode: on foot + packhorses Distance: 18 km Meal: Three meals a day, cooking on fire Accommodation: tents
4 day	Moving under Kara-Tyurek pass The camp is at the timber line.	Travel mode: on foot + packhorses Distance: 14 km Meal: Three meals a day, cooking on fire Accommodation: tents
5 day	Climbing up Kara-Tyurek pass Difficulty category - 1A, 3060 m, the nature of obstacles - talus, with a spectacular panoramic view of Belukha Mountain and endless peaks of Katun ridge. It provides a good opportunity for photo and video shooting. Overnight at the base camp at Ak-Kem lake (approx. 2010 m above sea level elevation).	Travel mode: on foot + packhorses Distance: 12 km Meal: Three meals a day, cooking on fire Accommodation: tents
6 day	Radial hike to Ak-Kemsky glacier and the lake of Mountain Spirits Visiting the chapel. The path runs along the Ak-kem lake through several picturesque hanging bridges, moves across stone piles in the form of an old moraine and leads to Ak-kem riverhead, coming out of the kingdom of ice and cold. Dinner at the Ak-Kem glacier. It provides an excellent opportunity for photo and video shooting. It is possible to climb up to the lake of Mountain Spirits on the way (optional, and depending on group's well-being).	Travel mode: on foot Distance: 20 km + 4 km Meal: Three meals a day, cooking on fire Accommodation: tents
7 day	Radial hike to Ak-Oyuk river gorge, valley of seven lakes and Yarlu valley (optional) The Ak-Oyuk riverhead has the most beautiful lakes, each of which has its own unique color: turquoise, green, milky-blue and blue-black. Descending to the base camp after the hike. Lunch. After lunch - excursion to Yarlu valley (optional), where the entire city is built of stones.	Travel mode: on foot Distance: 8 km + 6 km Meal: Three meals a day, cooking on fire Accommodation: tents



8 day	Descent along Ak-Kem river "Ak-Kem", translated from Turkic language, means "white water". Indeed, the river has milky- white water. The river starts in Ak-Kem glacier and carries small pieces of lime stone from Belukha slopes. Overnight near river in the forest.	Travel mode: on foot Distance: 16 km Meal: breakfast, lunch - cooking on fire, dinner in the cafe Accommodation: tents
9 day	End of the trip Move to camping "Three birches". Drive on GAZ-66 to Tyungur village. Moving from Tyungur to Ust-Koksa. Arrival at the tourist complex. Accommodation on the tourist complex territory in tents. Farewell party.	Travel mode: on foot + GAZ-66 - car Distance: 8 km + 20 km + 64 km Meal: breakfast in the cafe, lunch - cooking on fire, dinner in the cafe Accommodation: tents
10 day	Recreation Breakfast. Handing over the equipment. Free time. For additional fee the interested persons can choose either horseback riding in the vicinity or 2-hour rafting. Lunch. After lunch – excursion to Verkhniy Uymon village, which is one of the oldest villages in the Ust-Koksinsky area. The village was founded by Old Believers about 300 years ago. It has two museums: Local History Museum named after N.K. Roerich and Old Belief Museum. After the excursions, departure to Barnaul/Novosibirsk at 17:00 (UTC/GMT+7). Departure to Gorno-Altaisk at 21.00.
